# About Our Judge - Ralph Zeeman

Having come from a family of animal lovers, I grew up with dogs and there was always a corgi in the mix (of some description).

However, no one in my family was interested in the dog show scene and as such, it was not until adulthood that I took a firm interest in the sport of dogs.

In 2006 I got my first registered Pembroke and registered my membership with the Cape Welsh Corgi Club in Cape Town, South Africa and started showing my dog. After that first show, which happened to be the club's Golden Jubilee, I was bitten by that bug we all know.

During that same year I was recruited by the committee to assist with some ad hoc duties like reworking judges contracts and puppy purchase contracts for club members. This was the beginning of my involvement in 'organised dogdom'. The rest is history but an abbreviated timeline follows:

## Administrative Involvement:

- 2007- nominated and subsequently voted onto the committee of the Cape Welsh Corgi Club (CWCC) assuming the role of Treasurer. I remained on committee in this capacity until 2019.
- 2008-2019 – CWCC club representative at Western Cape Provincial Council (WCPC) meetings of the Kennel Union of Southern Africa (KUSA).
- 2013-2019—Executive Committee member of the Federal Council of KUSA for the WCPC. (voted into office by the WCPC)
- 2014- 2019—Vice Chairman of the WCPC (voted into office by WCPC)
- 2016-2019- Committee member of Kennel Association, All breeds Club in Cape Town
- 2017 to date - awarded an Honorary Life Membership of KUSA by virtue of my involvement at Executive Committee level.

## Judging

My success at breed and group level between 2006 -2010 sparked my interest in cynology and the nuances that informed this inexact science. So, during 2010 I registered my interest in the KUSA Judges Learnership Programme and was accepted as a Learner Judge.

- 2011 started the Learnership with the Herding Group (Gr 5 Aus) and qualified as a Champ Judge in 2014.
- 2014 qualified as Junior Showmanship Judge.
- 2014 continued Learnership to include Working Group (Gr 6 Aus) and qualified as a Champ Judge in 2017.

Continued to judge the breeds in these groups at both individual breed or group level (Open and Champ), both locally (Cape Town) and at interstate shows in South Africa until I relocated to Melbourne in 2019.
